

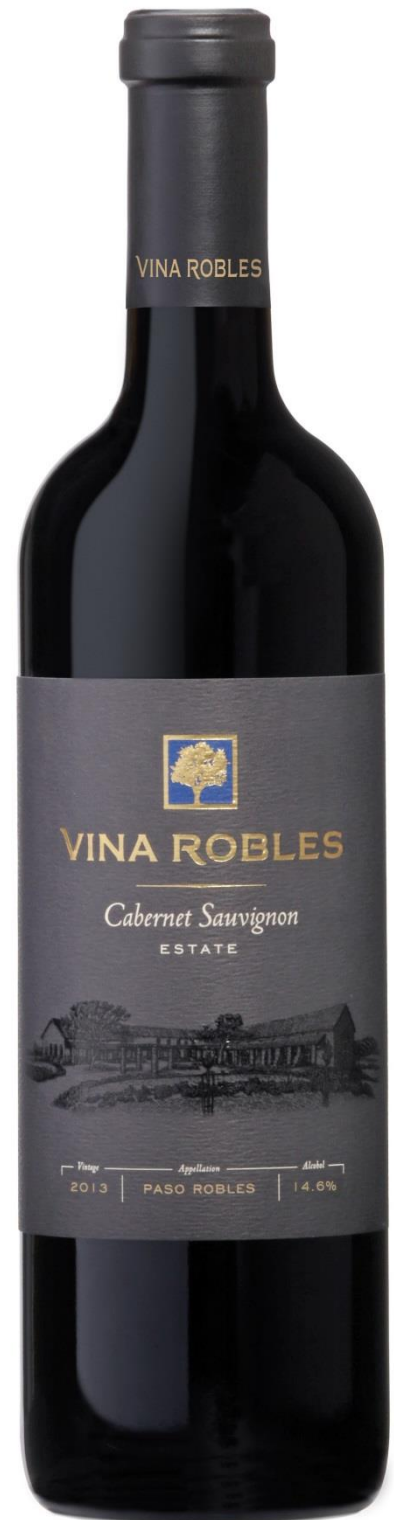

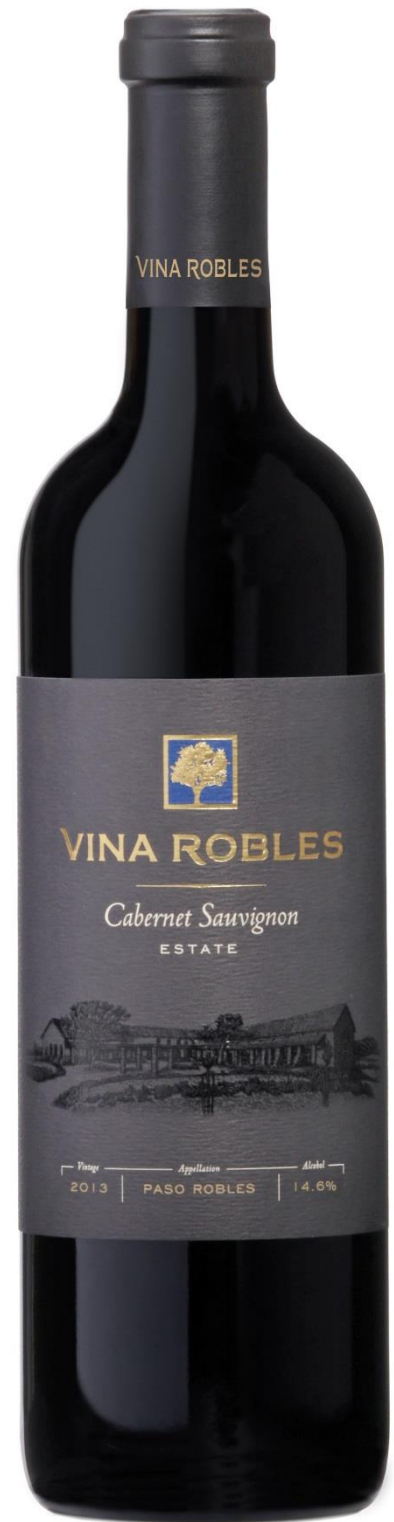

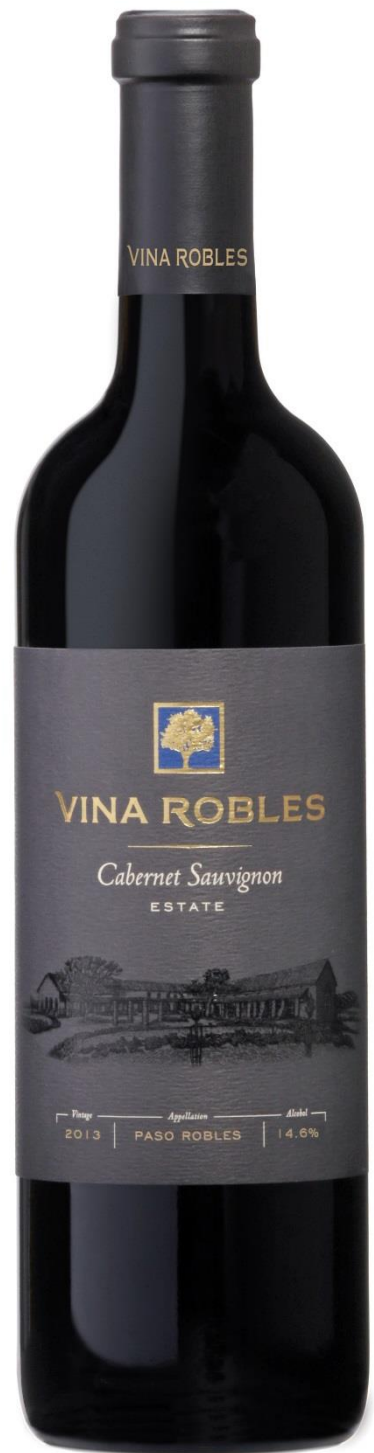

“Aromatics of black cherries, blackberries, and cassis meld with hints of dark chocolate, cedar, and clove on the nose. A sip delivers flavors of bramble fruit, currant, and dark cherry that flow into suggestions of sweet spice, toasty oak, and cocoa. Polished tannins combine with lush fruit for a very approachable Cab that’s a fine value at about \$25 a bottle.”
