Cabernet Sauvignon

2018 ♦ MOUNTAIN ROAD RESERVE ♦ PASO ROBLES

The fruit for our Mountain Road Reserve grows on two hillside vineyards at elevations of about 1,700 feet and only 12 miles from the Pacific Coast. Situated in the rugged coastal mountains west of Paso Robles in the Adelaida District, these prime sites feature rocky calcareous soils and southwestern exposures that lend themselves to producing stunning wines. It is here that the grapes for our award-winning Suendero are also grown.

This special selection focuses on very small lots of limited-production Cabernet Sauvignon, with a bit of Petit Verdot in the blend to enhance the structure of the finished wine. To achieve a balanced style with a rich character and refined mouthfeel, the wine was aged for 20 months in French oak barrels before bottling unfiltered and unfiltered.

Tasting Notes

COLOR: Garnet

AROMA: Cassis, blueberry, cedar and anise, with hints of black olives and juniper berry

TASTE: Full-bodied with cassis and blueberry, licorice notes, chewy and chalky tannins
