1. TECHNICAL TASKS – WINERY

- Assuming responsibility for winemaking work involving the crush and vinification process (including must & wine transfers, barrel work, draining, pressing, shoveling, cleaning, etc.)
- Operating and maintaining winery equipment (crushing equipment, press, pumps, forklift, barrel washer, minor plumbing, etc.)
- Performing winery lab analysis as needed (Brix, Temp., etc.)
- Receiving of goods (grapes, barrels, supplies, etc.)
- Completing all jobs according to Vina Robles' QC standards
- Operate in a safe and cooperative team environment
- Additional duties and responsibilities as needed

2. PLANNING & ADMINISTRATION

- Assist in coordinating cellar work with cellar master
- Recording of cellar work on work orders and/or work board
- Assist in maintaining complete and up-to-date inventory control for all wines in storage and all barrel inventory, cased goods, winery supplies, equipment and tools
